Stall Reservations:

Stall Reservations should be made with the Superintendent by July 15. Stall assignments will only be made by the Beef Superintendent.

Entries Taken: Entries and payment of fees on Sunday, July 29 from 11:00 AM – 2 PM at the barns.

Number of Class Entries:

Entries are limited to two (2) entries per class per exhibitor, unless noted otherwise. Animals must show in their proper classes, according to type, age, sex and breed.

Exhibiting Rule: All entries must be exhibited by the exhibitor. Exhibitor owning the animal must be present and in the show ring showing the animal in their classes. ONLY EXCEPTION: Exhibitor having 2 entries in same class.

Arrival of Animals: All Beef Animals will be on the fairgrounds by 12 Noon Sunday, July 29. No beef animals allowed on fairgrounds before 8 AM Saturday, July 28.

Livestock Health Regulations:

A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) are required as set forth in the State of Illinois 2018 Livestock Exhibition Regulations (Please read). Certificates will be checked at sign-in.

Bedding: Exhibitor is responsible for providing animal bedding. Livestock bedding must be wood chips or shavings unless otherwise approved by the Fairboard. Straw may be used only if loaded in dumpsters and not piled outside barns. All stalls and tie-outs are to be cleaned before animals leave the fairgrounds.

Fans: Only one fan for every three animals will be permitted. No fans will be allowed in walkways. **ABSOLUTELY NO BUTT FANS WILL BE ALLOWED**

Registration Papers: Registration Papers are required for all purebred breeding stock and will be checked at sign-in. Registration Papers must be in the name of the exhibitor and show ownership before June 1, 2017. Copies may be made if deemed necessary.

Ownership Dates: All beef must be in sole possession, owned and personally cared for by the exhibitor by June 1, 2018. None of these animals can be exhibited at any other fair after June 1, by any other exhibitor. No leased animals allowed to exhibit. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor and in the exhibitor's name.

Weighing of Animals: Market Animals will be weighed on Sunday, July 29 from 11 AM – Noon.

Release of Animals: All livestock and equipment will be released from the fairgrounds one (1) hours after the Youth Livestock Auction on Thursday, August 2. Early release to any exhibitor will result in forfeit of premiums.
