**Show Times:** 9 AM
- Poultry Premiums Offered:** \$1,320
- Exhibitor Fee:** \$5.00 each exhibitor in each department (Rabbit and Poultry count as one)
- Pen Rent:** \$1.00 per head. Number of Animals will be checked against entry form.
- Pen Reservations:** Pen Reservations must be made with the Superintendent by July 15, 2008. Pen assignments will only be made by the Poultry Superintendent.
- Entries Taken:** On-Line at [lawrencecountyfair.org](http://lawrencecountyfair.org) or by mail from June 20 until July 20. Sign-in and pay fees on Saturday, July 26 from 8:00 AM – 1 PM at the barns.
- Number of Animals per exhibitor:** Entries are limited to 12 animals per exhibitor.
- Number of Class Entries:** Entries are limited to two (2) entries per class per exhibitor, unless noted otherwise. Animals must show in their proper classes, according to type, age, sex & breed.
- Arrival of Animals:** All animals will be on the fairgrounds by 12 Noon Saturday, July 26, 2008. Absolutely No animals allowed on grounds before Saturday at 8 AM and No animals after 12 Noon.
- Bedding:** Exhibitor is responsible for providing own bedding.  
All pens are to be cleaned before animals leave the fairgrounds.
- Livestock Premises ID:** Premises Registration is voluntary to exhibit poultry at the 2008 county fair.
- Ownership Dates:** All poultry must be in sole possession and personally cared for by the exhibitor by June 1, 2008. None of these animals can be exhibited at any other fair after June 1, 2008, by any other exhibitor.
- Livestock Health Requirements:** Health certificates are required as set forth in the State of Illinois 2008 Livestock Exhibition Regulations (Please read). Certificates will be checked at sign-in..
- Release of Animals:** All livestock will be released from the fairgrounds one (1) hour after the 4H Livestock Auction. Early release will be allowed for OUT OF COUNTY Exhibitors (Non Lawrence County 4H) to remove livestock and equipment from the fairgrounds on Thursday morning, (ONLY) between 6 AM – 9:30 AM. After 9:30 AM no animals or equipment will be allowed to leave until one (1) hour after the auction.
- Rules:**
1. The General Rule and Regulations of the Fair apply in this department.
  2. Entries are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in the third grade by September 1, 2007 and not yet 19 years of age, on or before September 1, 2007.
  3. Animals not presented in the show ring at the time of show will forfeit their right to show.
  4. During judging, no one is allowed in the show ring except Judge(s), Exhibitors, and Ring Assistants (who are selected by the superintendent).
  5. Fair Association will not be responsible for loss of animals; exhibitors should take precautions to ensure their safety.
  6. Premium checks will be released after the 4-H auction only with superintendent's approval. (NO EXCEPTIONS). Exhibitor must sign a Premium statement to receive check.

**Junior Open:** Entries are open to junior exhibitors whose counties are reciprocal.

**Class Description:**

1. All birds must be marked by leg bands.
2. Commercial breeds are egg breeds, meat breeds and dual purpose breeds.
3. Bantams are miniature chickens weighing 1 to 2 pounds.
