- Exhibit Guidelines:** All entries shall be grown by the exhibitor. Exhibitor will furnish plates and containers for all exhibits.
- Display Guidelines:** Display classes shall be a maximum 2 feet by 4 feet and use a minimum of 10 varieties. Judging will be based on 75% Quality, 15% Labeling and 10% Attractiveness.
- Release of Exhibits:** Exhibits must be picked up on Friday, August 1, 2008 between 8 AM and 10 AM.

### **Rules:**

1. The General Rule and Regulations of the Fair apply in this department.
2. Junior Open entries are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in the third grade by September 1, 2007 and not yet 19 years of age, on or before September 1, 2007. Adult Open is open to anyone of ages 19 and over.
3. Premium checks will be released on Friday, August 1, 2008 between 8 AM and Noon.  
Exhibitor must sign a Premium statement to receive check.
