| Entries Taken: | Entries and pay fees by Saturday, July 29 from 8 – 10 AM at the barns. | |
| Number of Class Entries: | Entries limited to two (2) entries per class per exhibitor, unless noted otherwise. | |
| Exhibiting Rule: | All entries must be exhibited by the exhibitor. Exhibitor owning the animal must be present and in the show ring showing the animal in their classes. | |
| Arrival of Animals: | ALL horses that are going to be exhibited needs to be on the fairgrounds by 12 Noon, Saturday, July 29 to show in the Junior Open and must stay on the fairgrounds until release time. (See Release of Animals) | |
| Bedding: | Exhibitor is responsible for providing bedding. All stalls and tie-outs are to be cleaned before animals leave the fairgrounds. | |
| Livestock Health Requirements: | Health certificates are required as set forth in the State of Illinois 2017 Livestock Exhibition Regulations (Please read). Certificates will be checked at sign-in. | |
| Livestock Premises ID: | Premises Registration is voluntary to exhibit horses at the 2017 county fair. | |
| Ownership Dates and Paper: | Lease or ownership papers will be checked by the superintendent. Horses must be in sole possession and personally cared for by the exhibitor by June 1. None of these horses can be exhibited at any other fair after June 1 by any other exhibitor. Leased Horses are allowed in Horse Department only. | |
| Release of Animals: | All horses and all equipment will be released from the fairgrounds one (1) hour after the Youth Livestock Auction on Thursday, August 3, 2017. No early release applies to all exhibitors. | |

Rules:

1. The General Rule and Regulations of the Fair apply in this department.
2. Entries are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in the third grade by September 1, 2016 and not yet 19 years of age, on or before September 1, 2016.
3. Animals not presented in the show ring at the time of show will forfeit their right to show.
4. During judging, no one is allowed in the show ring except Judge(s), Exhibitors, and Ring Assistants (who are selected by the superintendent).
5. All exhibitors must sign a Premium Statement to receive premium check.

Junior Horse Show

New Rule: Riding Helmet required to be worn while mounted or driving on Horse. All exhibitors are required to wear a properly fitted ASTM or SEI standard F1163 (or above) certified equestrian helmet when ever mounted or driving at all Lawrence County Horse and pony events, shows, activities or practices. Original tags must be present in all approved helmets. The exhibitor is responsible to see that the headgear is properly fitted with the approved harness fastened snugly in place whenever mounted.

Protective helmets are recommended for all riders and drivers at all times. It is recommended that all adults working with exhibitors model the desired youth behavior by also wearing helmets whenever mounted or driving.

Junior Open: Entries are open to any junior exhibitors.
