Entry Fee: \$20.00 per class per animal per exhibitor.

Stall Reservations: Stall Reservations should be made with the Superintendent by July 15. Stall assignments will only be made by the Horse Superintendent.

Entries Taken: Entries and pay fees by Saturday, July 28 from 10 AM - Noon at the barns.

Number of Class Entries: Entries limited to two (2) entries per class per exhibitor, unless noted otherwise.

Exhibiting Rule: All entries must be exhibited by the exhibitor. Exhibitor owning the animal must be present and in the show ring showing the animal in their classes.

Arrival of Animals: ALL horses that are going to be exhibited needs to be on the fairgrounds by 11 AM, Saturday, July 28 to show in the Junior Open and must stay on the fairgrounds until release time. (See Release of Animals)

Bedding: Exhibitor is responsible for providing bedding. All stalls and tie-outs are to be cleaned before animals leave the fairgrounds.

Livestock Health Regulations: All horses, 12 months of age and older exhibiting shall be accompanied by a negative test for equine infectious anemia (EIA) conducted within the last 12 months. A copy of this test shall accompany the animal. AGID (Coggins) or ELISA tests are accepted.

Ownership Dates and Paper: Lease or ownership papers will be checked by the superintendent. Horses must be in sole possession and personally cared for by the exhibitor by June 1. None of these horses can be exhibited at any other fair after June 1 by any other exhibitor. Leased Horses are allowed in Horse Department only.

Release of Animals: All Horses and equipment will be released from the fairgrounds one (1) hours after the Youth Livestock Auction on Thursday, August 2. Early release to any exhibitor will result in forfeit of premiums.

Junior Open Horse Show

New Rule: Riding Helmet required to be worn while mounted or driving on Horse. All exhibitors are required to wear a properly fitted ASTM or SEI standard F1163 (or above) certified equestrian helmet when ever mounted or driving at all Lawrence County Horse and pony events, shows, activities or practices. Original tags must be present in all approved helmets. The exhibitor is responsible to see that the headgear is properly fitted with the approved harness fastened snugly in place whenever mounted.

Protective helmets are recommended for all riders and drivers at all times. It is recommended that all adults working with exhibitors model the desired youth behavior by also wearing helmets whenever mounted or driving.
