Pen Reservations: Pen Reservations should be made with the Superintendent by July 15. Pen assignments will only be made by the Poultry Superintendent.

Entries Taken: Entries and pay fees on Saturday, July 27 from 8 AM to 12 Noon at the barns.

Exhibiting Rule: All entries must be exhibited by the exhibitor. Exhibitor owning the birds must be present and in the show ring showing the birds in their classes. ONLY EXCEPTION: Exhibitor having 2 entries in same class.

Number of Animals per exhibitor: Entries are limited to 12 animals per exhibitor.

Number of Class Entries: Entries are limited to two (2) entries per class per exhibitor, unless noted otherwise. Animals must show in their proper classes, according to type, age, sex & breed.

Arrival of Animals: All animals will be on the fairgrounds by 11 AM Saturday, July 27.

Bedding: Exhibitor is responsible for providing own bedding. All pens are to be cleaned before animals leave the fairgrounds.

Ownership Dates: All poultry must be in sole possession, owned and personally cared for by the exhibitor by June 1. None of these animals can be exhibited at any other fair after June 1 by any other exhibitor. No leased animals allowed to exhibit. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor and in the exhibitor name.

Livestock Health Regulations: A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) are required as set forth in the State of Illinois 2019 Livestock Exhibition Regulations (Please read). Certificates will be checked at sign-in.

Release of Animals: All livestock and equipment will be released from the fairgrounds one (1) hours after the Youth Livestock Auction on Thursday, August 1. Early release to any exhibitor will result in forfeit of premiums.

Class Description:

1. Commercial breeds are egg breeds, meat breeds and dual purpose breeds.

2. Bantams are miniature chickens weighing 1 to 2 pounds.
