**Pen Rent:** **\$10.00 per head.**  
Number of Animals will be checked against entry form.

**Entry Fee:** **\$15.00 per class per animal per exhibitor.**

**Pen Reservations:** Pen Reservations should be made with the Superintendent by July 15. Pen assignments will only be made by the Swine Superintendent.

**Entries Taken:** Entries and pay fees on Saturday, July 28 from 12 Noon at the barns.

**Number of Class Entries:** Entries are limited to two (2) entries per class per exhibitor, unless noted otherwise. Animals must show in their proper classes, according to type, age, sex and breed.

**Exhibiting Rule:** All entries must be exhibited by the exhibitor. Exhibitor owning the animal must be present and in the show ring showing the animal in their classes. **ONLY EXCEPTION:** Exhibitor having 2 entries in same class.

**Arrival of Animals:** All Swine will be on the fairgrounds by 10 AM Saturday, July 28. All pigs will need to be inspected before unloading and penning. Inspection of animals will be Friday evening from 6:30 – 10 PM and after 7 AM on Saturday.

**Bedding:** Exhibitor is responsible for providing own bedding. All pens must be adequately bedded at all times. The superintendent reserves the right to place bedding in any pen they deem necessary at the exhibitors' expense. Bedding must be wood chips or shavings. All pens must be cleaned before animals leave the fairgrounds.

**Livestock Health Regulations:** A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) are required as set forth in the State of Illinois 2018 Livestock Exhibition Regulations (Please read). Certificates will be checked at sign-in.

**Ownership Dates:** All swine must be in sole possession, owned and personally cared for by the exhibitor by June 1. None of these animals can be exhibited at any other fair after June 1 by any other exhibitor. No leased animals allowed to exhibit. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor and in the exhibitor's name.

**Registration Papers:** Registration Papers are required for all purebred breeding stock and will be checked at sign-in. Registration Papers must be in the name of the exhibitor and show ownership before June 1. Copies may be made if deemed necessary.

**Weighing of Animals:** Market Animals and Commercial Breeding Swine will be weighed on Saturday, July 28 from 8 AM to 11 AM.

**Release of Animals:** All livestock and equipment will be released from the fairgrounds one (1) hours after the Youth Livestock Auction on Thursday, August 2. Early release to any exhibitor will result in forfeit of premiums.

## **Breeding Swine Show**

4. Breeding gilts cannot be shown in market classes. All gilts whether market or breeding will be weighed and weight broke for classes.
5. Breeding Gilts – farrowed after January 1, current year.
